The North Carolina Senior Women's Golf Association (NCSWGA) was established in 1968 and is dedicated to providing senior women throughout the state of North Carolina with the opportunity to compete in golf tournaments.

The first organizational meeting for the NCSWGA was held in March, 1968 when a group of interested and motivated women golfers gathered in Greensboro to create a platform to promote women's golf throughout the state. The annual dues were set at \$ 5 and the prize fee for the inaugural event at Pinehurst Country Club was \$10. Individual stroke play contests for first and second gross and net as well as low putts were part of the competition. Membership was limited to 200 members and within only a few years, the waiting list included as many as 163 names.

Our organization is a non-profit, volunteer-led organization that promotes the sport of golf and encourages women to stay active and engaged. We offer a senior statewide competition once a year, and our members enjoy the camaraderie and friendships that develop through our shared love of golf.
